Rachel Simmons began teaching printmaking and book arts at Rollins College in Winter Park, Florida in 2000 after completing her MFA at Louisiana State University in 1999. She currently serves as the Faculty Director of the Rollins Book Arts Collection and Vice Chair for Meetings for CBAA The Association for Book Art Education. Through her installations, artist's books, comics, prints and zines, Rachel explores tensions between individuals and societies as we navigate the impacts of globalization, technology, species decline and climate change. Rachel often collaborates with scholars and communities to create her work. In her ongoing socially engaged art project, *Flock*, Rachel invites community participants to explore both birdwatching and printmaking to examine our relationship with birds.
